NEW BUSINESS:

It was noted that the 2014 fire district budget was approved in the Feb. 15 public election. There were 38 votes for the budget and zero votes against it. Approved 37-1 in the election was the purchase of a ladder truck. Also in the election, Mark Blackwell and Bill Meytrott were re-elected to the fire commission. They took oaths of office for new three-year terms at the March 18 meeting. At that meeting, Mark Blackwell was re-elected chairman of the fire commission. Bill Meytrott was re-elected

vice-chairman. Tom Timperman was re-elected treasurer. John Tredrea was re-elected secretary and public agency compliance officer.
