APPROVAL OF MINUTES

TREASURER'S REPORT

Paying bills in the amount of \$12,364 was unanimously approved by roll call vote.

There were 49 calls in May, nine of them in the borough, chief DeForte reported. Satisfactory progress is being made on the purchase of the ladder truck, he said.

NEW BUSINESS

The commissioners who were present and the chiefs agreed that funding for a siren should be sought in a public election, either in a special election in October or as a separate ballot question in February.
