**NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING AND  
PUBLIC HEARING ON 2021 AMENDED BUDGET**

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 will hold a special meeting of the board for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing on a proposed amendment to the previously adopted 2021 Fire District Budget on **Wednesday, March 24, 2021, at 7:30 p.m.** The Public Hearing will be held during the meeting, which will be conducted remotely as a telephonic and virtual meeting via ZOOM. At the conclusion of the hearing the Board may formally act to adopt the amendment to the 2021 budget.

The amendment seeks to add \$15,000.00 to the total budget largely due to anticipated increases in Election costs that were not known at the time of the budget adoption.
