The proposed budget is \$94,835 higher than the current budget. The increase is due to \$164,009 budgeted for Air Packs and \$50,000 budgeted for a truck. Both purchases will be partially funded from the District's Capital Reserve Fund. The operating budget increased \$5,017 or 1.5% from last year.

2. Complete a brief statement describing the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unreserved Fund Balance(s). Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. If unreserved fund balance is reduced by more than 10%, explain the projected impact on the following year's budget.

The amount to be raised by taxes will increase \$1,229 and will have no impact on the tax rate, which will remain at \$.03 per \$100 of assessed valuation.

3. Include a statement explaining how the District is complying with the Property Tax Levy Cap. The statement must explain reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the district to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum.

The proposed budget remains under the Property Tax Levy.

4. If the District plans to pass a Resolution for the Release of Restricted Fund Balance, explain the reason and purposes of the appropriation

The District passed a resolution on November 15, 2011 authorizing the release of capital funds not to exceed \$225,000 for capital purchases.

5. Complete a brief statement on the Annual Budget's proposed capital appropriations and payment methods, including debt service for the proposed budget year and for future years.

The proposed budget includes appropriations for Air Packs in the amount of \$164,009 and a Truck in the amount of \$50,000. These purchases will be partially funded by the District's Capital Reserve Fund in the amount of \$174,647.

Shall Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 be authorized to include in the Capital Outlay Section of its 2012 budget a sum not to exceed \$50,000.00 to increase the amount previously approved by voters to purchase and outfit as much as possible a special services vehicle, and to fund this increase by transferring up to \$50,000.00 from its Restricted

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

A "yes" vote will authorize the Pennington Borough Board of Fire Commissioners to increase by up to \$50,000.00 the amount previously approved by voters to purchase and outfit as much as possible a special services vehicle for use at emergency scenes, and to include this amount (no more than \$50,000.00) in the capital outlay section of its 2012 budget. The cost of the vehicle, including this increase, will not exceed \$125,000.00 and will be paid entirely from the Board's Restricted Capital Fund (savings). As the entire cost is being paid from savings, it will not raise taxes or increase the tax rate.

PUBLIC QUESTION NO. 2

CAPITAL PURCHASE - SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS

Shall Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 be authorized to include in the Capital Outlay section of its 2012 budget the purchase of SCBA (Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus) for its volunteer firefighters at a total cost not to exceed \$173,500.00, and shall Fire District No. 1 in its discretion be authorized to pay for the SCBA by raising all or a part of its cost by taxation, or by paying all or a part from savings (Restricted Capital Fund), or by financing all or part of the cost in such amount and over such time as is approved by the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey?

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

A "Yes" vote will authorize the Pennington Borough Board of Fire Commissioners to include in its 2012 budget the purchase Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA's), including air packs, air bottles and breathing masks to replace 15 year-old SCBA that the law deems outdated and must be taken out of service in 2012. total cost of the SCBA will not exceed \$173,500.00. Pursuant to a Fire Protection Services Agreement between the Hopewell Township and Pennington Borough Fire Districts, Pennington Borough Fire District No. 1 expects to pay 24%, or an amount not to exceed \$41,640.00, of the cost of the SCBA, and the Hopewell Township Board is expected to contribute 76% of the cost of the SCBA to the Pennington Borough Board over a not more than 10 year repayment schedule. A 'yes' vote will also authorize the Pennington Borough Board of Fire Commissioners to pay for all or a part of the cost of the SCBA through taxation, or from savings (Restricted Capital Fund) or through financing as approved by the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey.
