WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for the <u>Pennington Borough Fire District No.</u> 1 (the "Fire District") for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of <u>November 17, 2015</u>; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.) and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$470.849, which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$220,404, and Total Appropriations of \$470.849; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on November 17, 2015 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District will consider the Annual Budget for adoption on January 19, 2016.

The 2015 budget was for \$778,754 which included a \$300,000 deposit for a new truck; not including the capital deposit the operating budget was \$478,754. The 2016 budget is for \$470,849 a decrease of \$7,905 or 1.65%.

The amount to be raised by taxation is down \$746. The budget for 2016 has the restricted fund balance increasing \$ 115,000
